

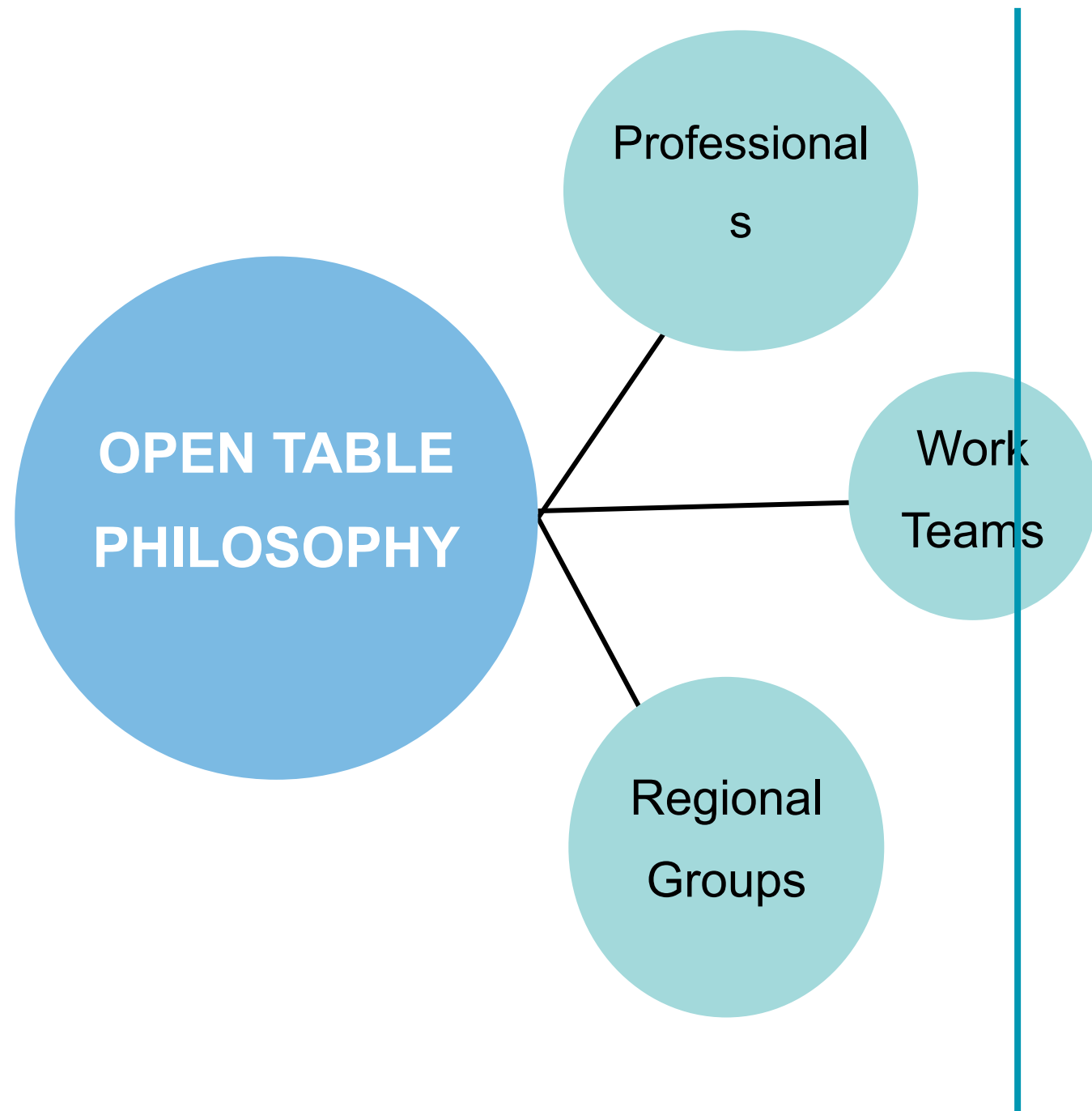

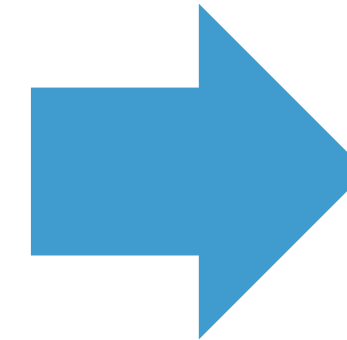

End-of-Life and Integrated Care Workshop Series: Practices and Challenges

1 Deconstructing knowledge on integrated and end-of-life care from a Latin American perspective

155 registered participants from the region

Exploration of knowledge and practices through participant experiences

2 Towards the creation of a Latin American community on integrated and end-of-life care

192 registered participants

Presentation and validation of themes related to governance, participation, and cultural relevance

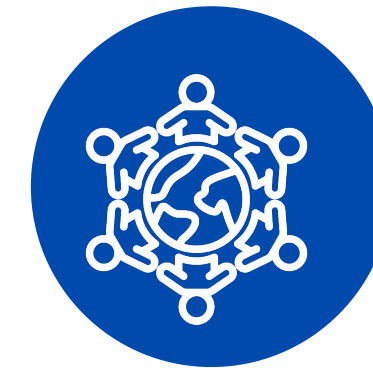
Governance

Participation

Understood as a society that influences, decides, and engages in end-of-life actions.



Cultural relevance

End-of-life actions centered on individuals throughout their life course.
